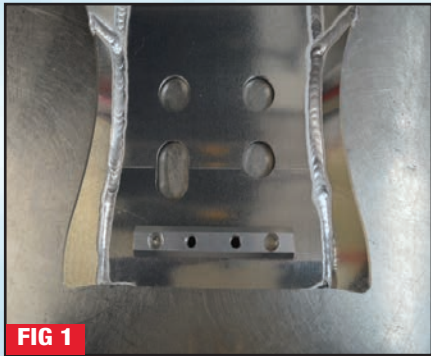

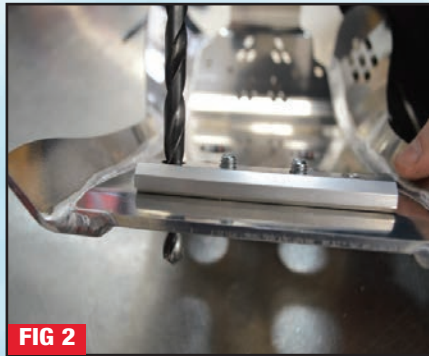

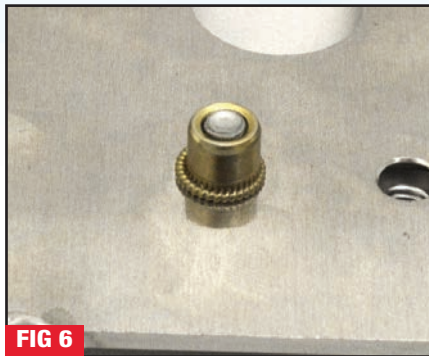

- 1 If the linkage guard is to be installed on a skid plate that is already installed on a bike, remove the skid plate from the bike.
- 2 Using the 8 x 20 flat head skid plate mounting bolts that came with your skid plate, mount the supplied drill template/insert installation tool to the top side of the skid plate as shown in (Fig 1)
- 3 Use the supplied 25/64" drill bit to start a hole in the skid plate at the location of the largest diameter hole of the drill template/installation tool as shown in (Fig 2)
- 4 Unbolt the drill template/installation tool and turn it 180 degrees and bolt it down again.
- 5 Repeat step 3 to start a hole in the other side of the skid plate.
- 6 Unbolt and remove the drill template/installation tool.
- 7 Finish drilling the 2 insert holes in the skidplate.
- 8 Insert one of the supplied threaded inserts in one of the holes you just drilled. Insert from the bottom of the skid plate. (Fig 3)
- 9 Using your Skid Plates rear mounting bolts, tighten down the installation tool snug against the Skid Plate.
- 10 Insert the supplied 6x30mm insert installation bolt and washer through the smaller insert installation hole in the drill template/insert installation tool (Fig 4) and thread it into the threaded insert until the head of the installation bolt is slightly snug against the drill template/insert installation tool. (Fig 5)
- 11 Now tighten the insert installation bolt until the end of the bolt is flush with the end of the insert. (Fig 6)
- 12 Remove the insert installation bolt and installation tool.
- 13 Insert the other supplied threaded insert into the other drilled hole you drilled. Insert from the bottom of the skid plate.
- 14 Repeat steps 9, 10 and 11 to seat the other supplied threaded insert
- 15 Mount the skid plate on the bike by following the skid plate installation instructions.
- 16 Mount the linkage guard to the skid plate using the supplied 6 x 20mm hex head bolts and the supplied dished washers.
