

Skid Plate Installation Instructions

- 1** Hook the 2 supplied rear clamps over the rear cross section part of the frame as shown in **(figure 1)**.
- 2** Insert the front attachment bar over the top of the frame as shown in **(figure 2)**. The machined flat should face the engine.
- 3** Hold the skid plate in place and start the 2 front 8 x 40mm mounting bolts. These bolts screw into the front attachment bar as shown in **(figure 3)**. Do not tighten bolts yet.
- 4** Now start the shorter 8 x 20mm mounting bolts in the rear. In **(figure 5)** you will see that the skid plate has four holes, on the linkage bikes you will use the center 2 holes and the non linkage bike the outer 2 holes. These bolts screw into the rear clamps as shown in **(figure 4)**. Do not tighten bolts yet.

- 5** Make sure the skid plate is well centered then tighten the front and rear mounting bolts using a 5mm Allen wrench.

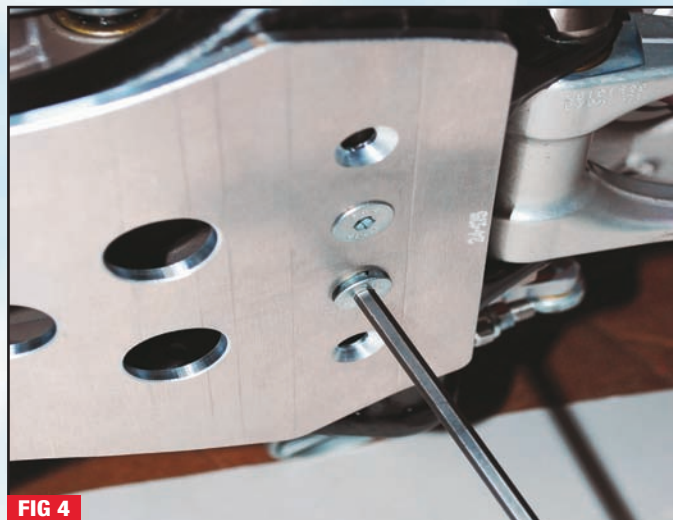

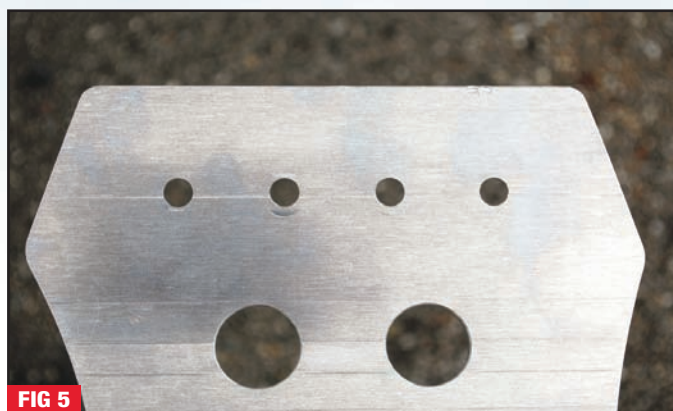
