Yamaha Skid Plate Instructions

Remove the factory skid plate; there are three bolts (two in the front and one below).


² Position the rear clamp (573-02) above the frame tab that the factory skid plate mounted to, **See photo 1.0**. Insert the provided 6x20 Button head bolt into the tab.

NOTICE: This bolt is intended to hold the clamp in location during the install, not to fasten the clamp to the frame tab. **See photo 1.1.**

³ Locate the EE skid plate so that the front two mounting holes align with the factory mounting holes on the frame. **See photo 2.0.** Insert the two provided 6x16 hex head bolts along with the provided washers, only finger tighten at this time.

⁴ Arrange the provided 8 x 40 flat head bolts through the skidplate and supplied spacer as shown in **photo 3.0**. Rotate the skid plate up toward the frame aligning the 8x40 bolts with the clamp that was installed in step #2.

⁵ Once all mounting bolts have been started, you can now tighten them, alternating from front to back until skid plate is secure.





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
